**REVISED POLICY DIRECTIVE FOR RURAL ELECTRIFICATION AND RELEASE OF
AGRICULTURE CONNECTIONS AND MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH.**

Whereas, the State Government had issued revised Policy Directive on 26.8.2010 for promotion of energy conservation and efficient use of water in agriculture sector.


Chairman Discoms vide letter No.JPD/CMD/SE/Comm1./XEN (BD)/F.D.445 dated 7.4.2011 has proposed that the subsidy amount on star rated energy efficient agricultural pumpsets (three star and above) be enhanced from Rs. 500/- per HP to Rs. 750/- per HP for further encouraging the farmers to use the energy efficient agricultural pumpsets.

Whereas, the State Government reviewed the position in the light of proposal of Chairman Discoms and considered necessary to issue following amendment in Point No.2 of Policy Directive dated 26.8.2010 :-

The existing provision of Point No.2 of the said Policy Directive shall be replaced by the following:-


"(2) The farmers who opt for the installation of energy efficient pump sets, would be provided a subsidy of Rs. 750/- per HP by Discoms and the amount of subsidy would be adjusted in the monthly electricity bills issued to the farmers in 12 equal installments."

This will come into force with immediate effect.
